Beau Sejour Leisure Centre is Guernsey's only community leisure centre and offers facilities and services of the highest quality for sports and leisure pursuits.

The Centre is a division of the States of Guernsey Education, Sport and Culture.

Originally built in 1976, following a States of Guernsey directive to provide an affordable leisure facility, Beau Sejour is located on the outskirts of St Peter Port. It was upgraded between 2001 and 2003, and has modern equipment which caters for many leisure services and activities, allowing access for everybody regardless of age, gender or ability.

Beau Sejour provides facilities for individuals, children and families, and corporate functions. The Centre is also an excellent venue for shows, musicals and just about any type of live entertainment.

Annual footfall is upwards of 515,000, including young children and families to older adults, all taking part in a large number of leisure, sport, health and recreational activities.

Beau Sejour is a flexible space that has a variety of spaces which can be adapted to fulfill event criteria.

This includes:

- ✓ **Main function hall (David Ferguson Hall)**
- ✓ **Theatre**
- ✓ **3 meetings rooms**
- ✓ **Sports hall (Sir John Loveridge Hall)**
- ✓ **Separate entrance/function space (Concourse)**
- ✓ **5 squash courts**
- ✓ **2 swimming pools**
(one learner pool, and one main pool)
- ✓ **Modern gym**
- ✓ **Café**
- ✓ **1 wet changing room and
2 dry changing rooms**

The Centre's parkland also includes two outdoor pitches and tennis/netball courts.

Saumarez Room

The Saumarez Room is located on level one. The room has two roof lights and also has air conditioning. There is full wheelchair access to the room.

The room can be hired for meetings in four-hour blocks, with different layouts available to suit your needs (see diagrams).

✓ **Lectern (aluminium)**

For an additional cost, catering and mics (with a sound system) are also available.

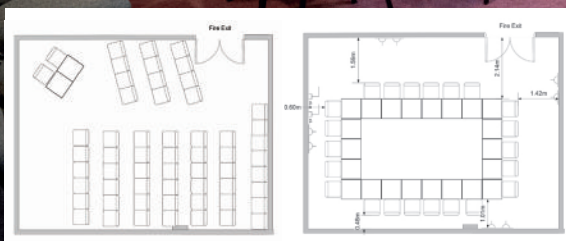

Theatre

The Theatre is used for local and touring stage productions, arts events, conferences, presentations, meetings and product launches.

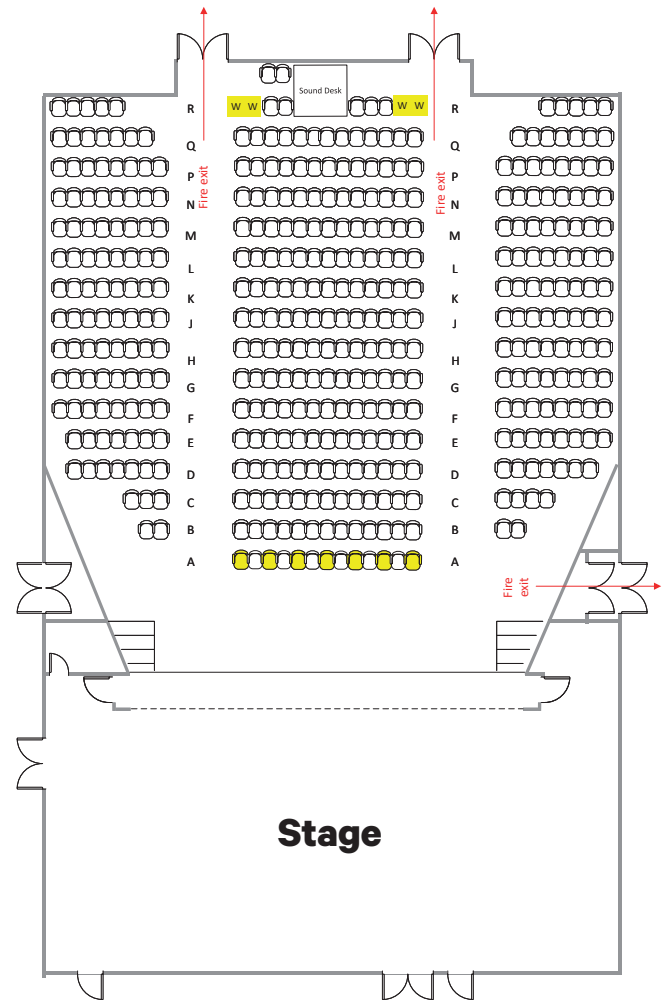
The Theatre seats 401 people in total and is set with permanent raked seating. There is a removable orchestra pit in front of the stage or alternatively a thrust stage can be set in-front of the stage.

There are two large dressing rooms, two small dressing rooms to the side of the stage, and a further four small dressing rooms in the scene dock behind the stage.

A scene dock is available at the rear of the stage but due to the number of bookings storage is only available a few days either side of productions. In addition there is a cinema screen and digital projector with a JBL 7.2 Surround Sound system. The screen is six metres by four metres which will vary depending on projected image.

Wheelchair access is available to all areas of the Theatre including the stage and dressing rooms.

Theatre seating plan

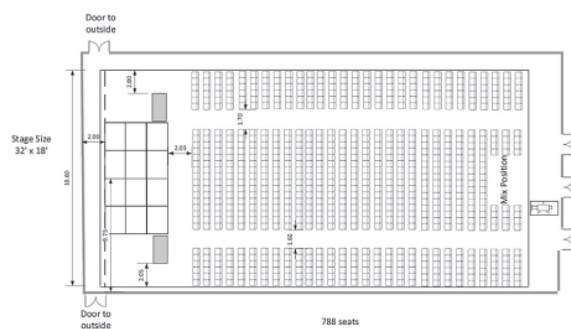

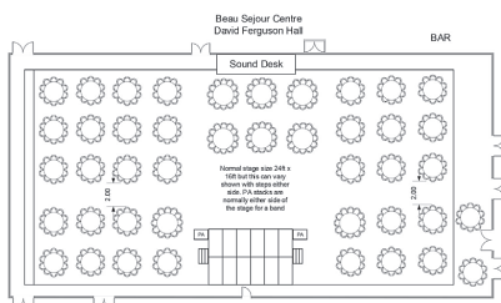
The David Ferguson Hall

The David Ferguson Hall is a multi-function hall for which the capacity varies depending on the layout. Maximum capacities are listed for different layouts below but it must be stressed that these layouts are dependent on stage size, theming and specific layouts:

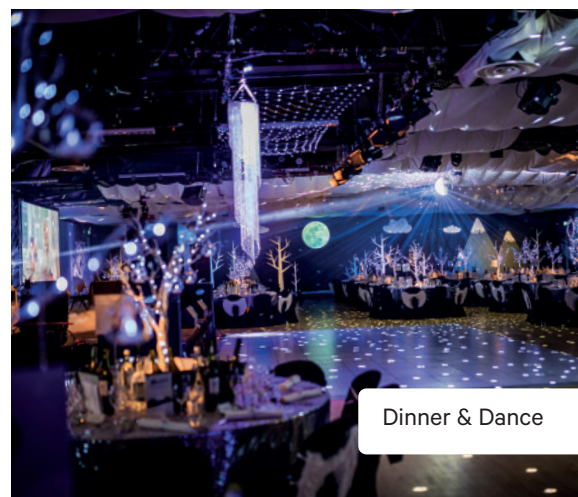

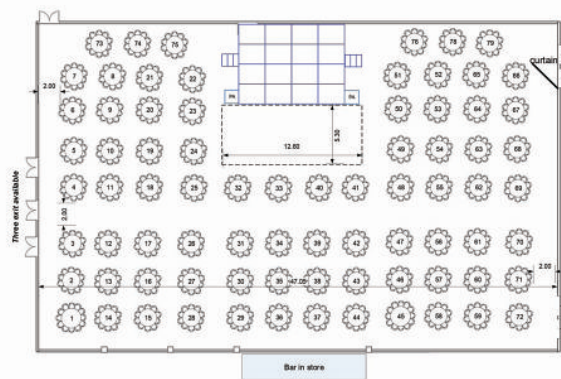
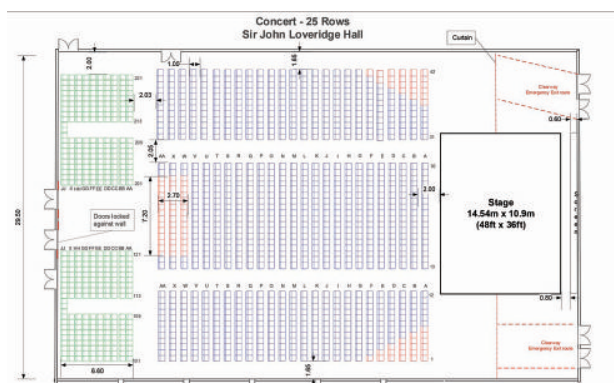


Seated concert layout

The Sir John Loveridge Hall

The Sir John Loveridge Hall is a Sports Hall and bookings are limited particularly during the sporting season which runs from September to May inclusive. Again maximum capacities are listed for different layouts below but it must be stressed that these layouts are dependent on stage size, themed and specific layouts.

There are no dressing rooms attached to this room, there are 2 small rooms with a toilet accessible via a corner door in the Sir John Loveridge Hall and 2 dry changes on Level 1. Access to these rooms is via the squash courts which will remain in use.

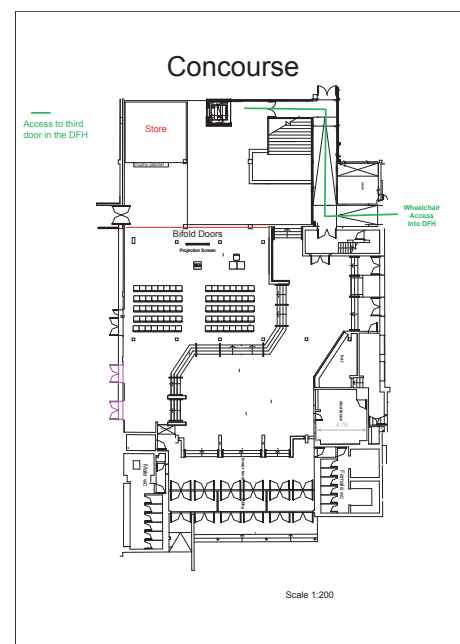
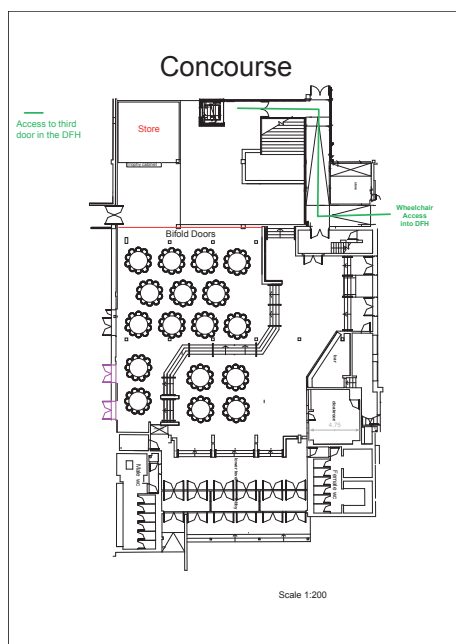
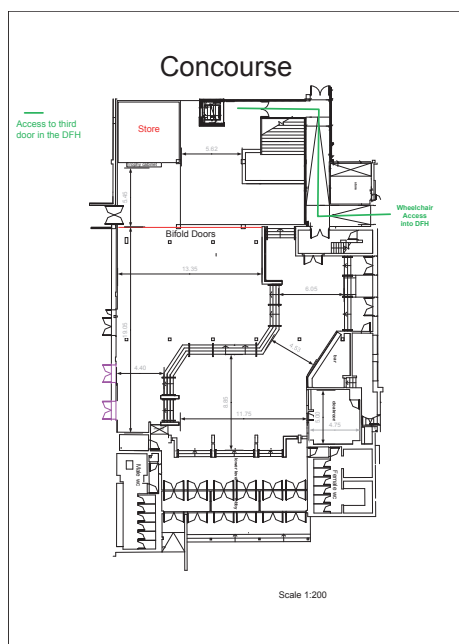
The Concourse

The Concourse is a room that links the Sir John Loveridge Hall and the David Ferguson Hall.

The room provides the facilities of cloakroom, function toilets (including a disabled toilet) cloakroom and a bar facility if required. This room can be used as a private entrance for functions in the Sir John Loveridge Hall or the David Ferguson Hall or it can be used as a bookable space in its own right. Theatre style setup above features 115" screen.

The room is split into two different levels and provides the rear entrance to the Centre.

Recently a dividing wall has been added to this room so it is now possible to book the room as a private area.
